RAINIERS NOTES

Unfinished Business: The Rainiers have not advanced to the postseason since 2005 and have not won the PCL title since 2001. Tacoma has won five PCL titles, and no affiliate has won more than one title: 2001 Tacoma Rainiers, 1978 Tacoma Yankees, 1969 Tacoma Cubs, 1961 Tacoma Giants, and 1904 Tacoma Tigers. Right-handed pitcher Denny Stark has the opportunity to become the first Tacoma player to win two PCL titles, as he was a member of the 2001 Rainiers championship club.

Award Season: Gaby Hernandez was awarded the 2009 "King of the Hill" award. Bryan LaHair was awarded the 2009 Offensive Player of the Year. Adam Moore was awarded the 2009 Most Valuable Player.

Chicks Dig the Long Ball: The Rainiers ended the regular season with more home runs than any team in affiliated minor league baseball (166). Fellow Seattle Mariners affiliate, the High Desert Mavericks, earned the second-highest minor league home run total (164).

Career Advancement: Bryan LaHair ended the 2009 ranked among the best in Tacoma baseball history. LaHair ranks first in doubles (110), third in at bats (1,527) and total bases (733), and fourth in hits (433), runs (226), RBI (263), and home runs (60).

Single Season Records: Several Rainiers rank among the franchise's top-10 single season leaders: Bryan LaHair's 26 home runs rank tenth; Jerry Owens's 23 stolen bases rank eighth; Mike Carp's 12 hit by pitches rank fifth, and Randy Messenger's 25 saves rank third.

Well-Earned Promotion: Left-handed pitcher Nick Hill made his AAA debut last night as he pitched 1.0 innings in relief. Hill started 2009 at AA West Tennessee. He went 5-6 with two saves, three complete games, and a 3.10 ERA (33 ER/95.2 IP) in 36 games and nine starts. Hill amassed 84 hits, only five home runs, 24 walks, and 100 strikeouts in those 95.2 innings. Hill is a graduate of United States Military Academy (West Point).

New Season, Same Talent: Matt Tuiasosopo collected his first extra base hit – a double – of the postseason last night. Tuiasosopo batted .281 (56x199) with 14 doubles, 11 home runs, 41 runs, and 34 RBI in 51 regular season games since the All-Star break.

Finishing Strong: Team MVP Adam Moore finished the regular season with a five-game hit streak over which he batted .400 (8x20) with two runs and four RBI.

Closing Shop: Right-handed pitcher Robert Manuel closed out the 2009 regular season with four saves and a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) in his last 10 relief appearances. Manuel – who joined the Rainiers from the playoff-bound Louisville Bats on 7/29 – walked two, struck out six, and held opponents to a .167 batting average (7x42) over that 10-game stretch.

ACQUIRED: Traded from Chicago (NL) with Ronny Cedeno in exchange for Aaron Heilman on January 28, 2009...Part of two offseason trades...acquired by Chicago (NL) for Felix Pie on January 18, 2009...traded to Seattle ten-days later...Baltimore's 2nd selection (sandwich pick) in the 2005 First Year Player Draft; 48th selection overall...that draft choice was compensation for failure to sign RHP Wade Townsend; first round selection in the 2004 draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned no decision in a 6-4 victory versus Colorado Springs on 9/5...Threw 100 pitches and 64 strikes to 28 over 6.0 innings...allowed four earned runs and seven hits, four singles and three doubles...walked three and struck out five...allowed one stolen base with catcher Adam Moore...induced three ground outs and 10 fly outs.

VERSUS THE RIVER CATS: 0-1 with 6.48 ERA (6 ER/8.1 IP) in two starts (4/10 & 4/20)...allowed six hits, which included four doubles (Baisley, Carson, Doolittle, and Patterson), one triple (Doolittle), and no home runs...held batters to .200 average (6x30)...walked six and struck out six...threw 164 pitches and 96 strikes (58.5%) to 38 batters...hit two batsmen (Barton & Patterson)...induced nine ground outs and 10 fly outs.

2009: Struck out nine batters in 11.1 IP at 2009 spring training...went 2-2 with 3.08 ERA (9 ER/26.1 IP) in five starts (all in April) with Tacoma...held AAA batters to a .138 batting average...has not allowed more than four hits or three runs with Tacoma...struck out six twice...recalled to Seattle on 5/6...went 3-5 with a 5.88 ERA (49 ER/75.0 IP) in 24 games and 11 starts with Seattle...earned a 6.49 ERA (38 ER/52.2 IP) as a starter and a 4.43 ERA (11 ER/22.1 IP) as a reliever...held MLB batters to a .263 batting average...went 3-1 with a 4.94 ERA (13 ER/23.2 IP), .225 batting average, five walks, and 11 strikeouts over seven games in June with Seattle.

2008: went 1-1 with 1.85 ERA in five April starts at Norfolk (AAA)...Recalled to Baltimore on April 29, 2008...went 9-10 with a 6.65 ERA in 26 starts for the Orioles...ranked 4th among AL rookies in starts (26), 5th in wins (9), 5th in innings pitched (132.2), and 6th in strikeouts (83)...started the season 5-1 with a 3.86 ERA (19 ER, 44.1 IP) through his first eight MLB starts...pitched a career-best 8.1 IP with 3 ER on 11 hits August 1, 2008 at Seattle...struck out a career-best 7 batters May 5, 2008 at Oakland.
