### RAINIERS NOTES

**Responding in Kind:** The Rainiers are 5-1 when facing elimination: 3-1 in 2005 and 2-0 in 2001. Additionally, the Rainiers are 4-0 when facing elimination by the Sacramento River Cats, including an amazing three-game sweep at Sacramento in 2005.

**Unfinished Business:** The Rainiers have not advanced to the postseason since 2005 and have not won the PCL title since 2001. Tacoma has won five PCL titles, yet no affiliate has won more than one title: 2001 Rainiers, 1978 Yankees, 1969 Cubs, 1961 Giants, and 1904 Tigers. Denny Stark has the opportunity to become the first Tacoma player to win two PCL titles. Stark played for the 2001 Rainiers championship club.

**Award Season:** Gaby Hernandez was awarded "King of the Hill." Bryan LaHair was awarded Offensive Player of the Year. Adam Moore was awarded team MVP.

**The Biggest Hurt:** The Rainiers ended the regular season with more home runs than any team in affiliated minor league baseball (166). Fellow Seattle Mariners affiliate, the High Desert Mavericks, earned the second-highest minor league home run total (164).

**Career Advancement:** Bryan LaHair ended 2009 ranked among the best in Tacoma baseball history. LaHair ranks first in doubles (110), third in at bats (1,527) and total bases (733), and fourth in hits (433), runs (226), RBI (263), and home runs (60).

**Single Season Records:** Several Rainiers rank among the franchise's top-10 single season leaders: Bryan LaHair's 26 home runs rank tenth; Jerry Owens's 23 stolen bases rank eighth; Mike Carp's 12 hit by pitches rank fifth, and Randy Messenger's 25 saves rank third.

**Right Tool for the Job:** Gaby Hernandez has not lost a decision since 7/28, won five consecutive starts, and won seven of his last eight starts.

**Southpawless:** The Rainiers have not faced a left-handed pitcher in their first three postseason games of 2009. The Rainiers batted .297 (60x202) versus left-handed River Cats pitchers during the regular season.

**Moore Than Enough:** Adam Moore finished 2009 with a five-game hit streak in which he batted .400 (8x20) with two runs and four RBI. Moore has also collected a hit in each of the first three post-season games (3x12).

**Bringing the Lumber:** Redman batted .425 (17x40) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 runs, and seven RBI in 10 regular season games versus Sacramento, and he has batted .455 (5x11) with two doubles and two runs in three post-season contests.

**Hit Factory:** Oswaldo Navarro has registered a hit in 18 of his last 19 games: 15 of his final 16 regular season games plus all three post-season games.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned tenth win – fifth consecutive – in the 11-2 division pennant-clinching victory versus Colorado Springs on 9/7...threw 106 pitches and 70 strikes to 25 batters over 6.0 innings...allowed two runs, and one earned run, on a season-low three hits: one single, one double, one solo home run...walked three and struck out a season-high eight...

**VERSUS THE RIVER CATS:** 0-2 with 8.16 ERA (13 ER/14.1 IP) in three starts (4/11, 6/14, and 7/23)...surrendered 23 hits: seven doubles (Barton, Chen, Everidge, Patterson 2, and Pennington 2), one triple (Patterson), and one home run (Hannahan)...held batters to .365 average (23x63)...walked four and struck out 10...threw 233 pitches and 153 strikes (65.6%) to 67 batters...committed two wild pitches...induced 17 ground outs and 15 fly outs...allowed one stolen base (Patterson) with catcher Jeff Clement.

**2009:** Snapped team-high 10-game winless streak on 8/2; 0-7 with 7.36 ERA (42 ER/51.1 IP) over that span...won three straight appearances in May; 2.75 ERA (5 ER/16.1 IP)...lost a team-high four consecutive appearances in June; 6.85 ERA (16 ER/21 IP)...3-2 with a 3.22 ERA (13 ER/36.1 IP) and .235 batting average in May...struck out a season high eight (in 5.0 IP) versus Reno on 6/19...has incurred only six unearned runs this season and none from 6/25 to 9/2...has not lost a game since 7/28 at Reno.
